Virtually all INNIO's products contain one or more of the minerals tin, tantalum, tungsten and gold (3TG). The mining and trade of these materials from the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and surrounding countries have gained international attention for the role that they can play as "conflict minerals," financing deadly armed groups in the region. Because of this potential for association with conflict and human rights abuses, INNIO strives to ensure that our supply chains are ethical and sustainable, and that we are fulfilling our commitment to respect human rights through responsible sourcing practices.

We support industry-wide due diligence mechanisms that enable conflict-free sourcing in general, such as the [Responsible Minerals Initiative](#). In addition, INNIO supports the [10 principles of the UN Global Compact](#) on human rights, labor, the environment and anti-corruption.
